In Copenhagen and Trollhättan we stay two nights in the hotel; at the other locations we stay one night. We stay in varied and comfortable hotels on bed and breakfast basis (At most hotels dinner is also included).

During the trip, we will also visit the Saab Museum. Here we can admire up close the complete history of Saab, from the very first UrSaab to the last Saab 9-5 NG and everything in between. In the evening we enjoy dinner amidst the impressive collection at the Saab Museum, a unique and atmospheric experience.

# **Information per day**

### Day 1 - Copenhagen

The meeting point is the city of Copenhagen in Denmark. Day 1 is therefore dedicated to arriving, gathering and getting acquainted. There will be no ride on this day. In the early evening we will toast to a fun and successful trip and the road book will be handed out and explained. We will stay the first 2 nights in a hotel right in the culinary heart of Copenhagen. We can safely park the cars in a covered parking garage within walking distance of the hotel.

### Day 2 - Copenhagen

The first day in Copenhagen can be filled as you wish. You can choose to explore the city, take a tour in your Saab, or a combination of both activities. Dinner for this evening is not included and i s to be filled on an individual basis, with Copenhagen offering plenty of choice. The hotel is ideally located, close to the most popular sights and surrounded by numerous atmospheric restaurants where you can enjoy a delicious meal.

**Copenhagen** is located on the east coast of the island of Zealand (Sjælland) and on the island of Amager. The city lies on the Sound (Øresund). Across this strait lies the Swedish city of Malmö, which has been connected to Copenhagen by the Öresund Bridge since 2000. Besides being the seat of parliament and residence, Copenhagen is also the cultural and economic center of Denmark.

The city was founded in the Middle Ages and became the capital of Denmark at the end of the Middle Ages. The name Copenhagen goes back to Købmandshavn, which means "Merchant's Port." However, the name Merchant Harbour is no longer an accurate description of the city: Copenhagen is no longer a port city, and industry has also largely left. Now Copenhagen is mainly a service city.

### Day 3 - Copenhagen - Unnaryd (+/- 266 km)

On this third day of travel we will drive through the interior of Sweden to Unnaryd. The route will be through several inland roads with forests and lakes. We will spend the night and dine at a traditional Swedish wooden hotel located directly on Lake Bolmen.

**Unnaryd** is a place in the municipality of Hylte in the province of Hallands län the place, however, is located in the Småland landscape in Sweden. The place has 760 inhabitants (2005) and an area of 123 hectares. The nature surrounding Unnaryd consists mainly of forest and the many lakes. The area is relatively sparsely populated.









# **Information per day**

### Day 4 - Unnaryd — Trollhättan (+/- 225 km)

This day we will travel to the birthplace of Saab Trollhättan. The route from Unnaryd includes Lake Åsunden and many other smaller lakes. Our hotel overlooks the water and the center of Trollhättan. Here we will stay for the next 2 nights.

**Trollhättan** is the capital of the municipality of Trollhättan in the landscape of Västergötland and the province of Västra Götalands län in Sweden. The name "Trollhättan" comes from folkloric tales. People believed that large trolls lived in the Göta älv and that the islands in the river were the hats ("hättor") of the trolls, hence the name Trollhättan. "Hättan," however, can also mean 'mountain top,' and an alternative explanation for 'troll' is 'to pull,' which would then refer to pulling boats across the rapids.

### Day 5 - Trollhättan - SAAB Museum

Today we will take a short drive in the surroundings of Trollhättan, after which we will visit the Saab Museum in the afternoon. This afternoon is dedicated to a special meeting between Saab Club Netherlands and Svenska Saabklubben. At the museum we can enjoy the impressive Saab collection, from the iconic UrSaab to the latest Saab 9-5 NG. In the evening, we end the day with an atmospheric dinner amidst the unique museum collection at the Saab Museum. An unforgettable experience for every Saab enthusiast!

**SAAB museum** On June 10, 1947, the aircraft manufacturer Saab - Swedish Aeroplanes aktiebolaget - presented its first car, the Saab 92. Series production began in 1949 in Trollhättan. Until the end of 2011, Saab Automobile produced cars that were happily driven all over the world. At the Saab Car Museum, you can experience the complete story, from the first prototype to the last car ever built.

### Dayg 6 - Trollhattan — Klovedal (+/- 132 km)

On the sixth travel day we bid farewell to Trollhättan and set sail for the coast of Sweden. Our route includes the picturesque islands of Tjörn and Orust, before finally arriving in Björholmen (Klövedal).

**Klövedal** is a small town in Sweden, located on the island of Tjörn, which is part of the province of Västra Götalands län and the region of Bohuslän on the country's west coast. The area is known for its beautiful natural surroundings and characteristic coastal scenery.









# Information per day

### Day 7 - Klovedal - Varberg (+/- 175 km)

Today unfortunately marks the last day of driving. We drive along the Swedish west coast towards Varberg. Upon arrival there will be an opportunity to relax at the hotel, which offers a magnificent view of the bay. In the evening we conclude the trip in style with a toast and a communal dinner.

**Varberg** is a charming coastal town on the west coast of Sweden, in the province of Halland. It is known for its rich history, beautiful nature and excellent facilities for relaxation. One of the most iconic sights in Varberg is the medieval castle that rises high above the coast. Built in the 13th century, it offers not only a glimpse of history but also spectacular views of the sea.

### Day 8 - Varberg - going home

This day is all about waking up peacefully, enjoying a good breakfast, checking out and beginning the journey back home or to your next destination.

- All information and prices are subject to change.

- If you wish to cancel after registration, this must be done in writing. Depending on the time of cancellation, the following fees will be charged:
  - -For cancellation from registration until March 01, 2025: 50€ registration fee
  - -For cancellation from March 01, 2025 to April 01, 2025: 30% of the total fare
  - -For cancellation from April 01, 2025 to May 01, 2025: 50% of the total fare
  - -For cancellation from May 01, 2025 to June 01, 2025: 75% of the total fare
  - -For cancellation from June 01, 2025: 100% of the total fare.
